¹ Respondents are able to list multiple responses for their ethnic ancestry. The totals for each ethnic origin group include those respondents who listed that group as their only ethnic origin AND those who listed the ethnic origin in combination with other origins. Therefore, the sum of ethnic origins will NOT equal the total population due to multiple counts.
