

# Logitech Webcam Pro 9000

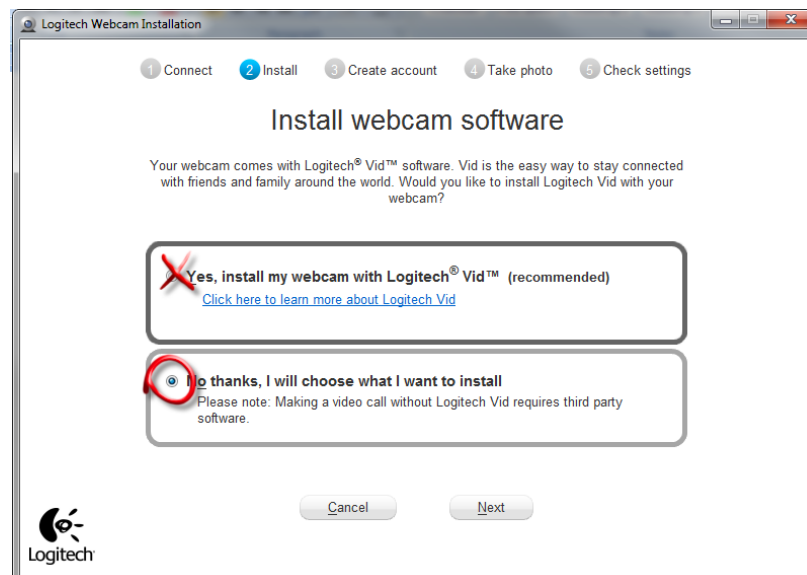
## Installation:

\*\*do not plug in webcam before instructed to do so.

- Place CD into drive – if Setup doesn't start automatically:
  - Go to My Computer
  - Select CD/DVD drive
  - Double click on Setup.exe
- Depending on the version of windows, you may get a pop-up security window similar to the below (to the right). Click Yes/OK

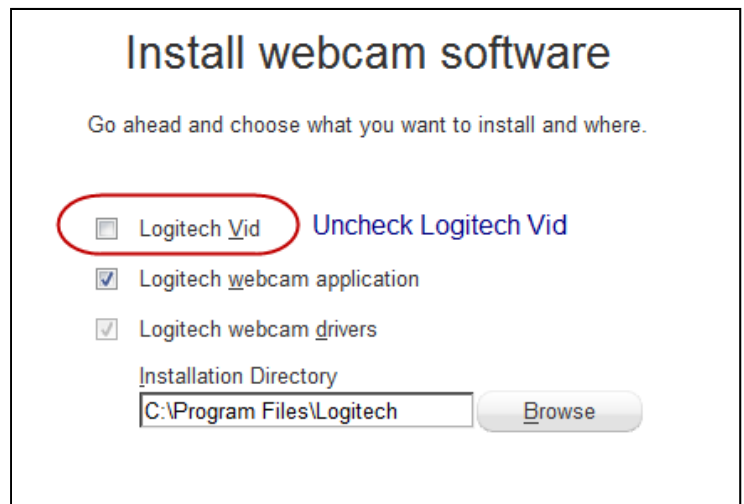


- Welcome Screen – choose language of choice – click to agree to the terms of service – click NEXT
- When prompted, plug in WebCam into a USB slot
- This will take several seconds to respond...please wait
- Once the screen says the WebCam was successfully installed, click OK
- The software will now check for updates
- Install webcam software
- Please choose "No Thanks, I will choose what I want to Install"
- Next



- Uncheck Logitech Vid
- Click Next

Logitech Vid is a piece of software that allows you to login and to video chat with other Logitech Vid users.



- The software will now install – while it is installing, there will be different bits of information shown on the screen.
- Once the software is finished installing, you will have a chance to check the settings.
- If you are happy with the settings click Next, otherwise click Change
- When finished, click Let's Go

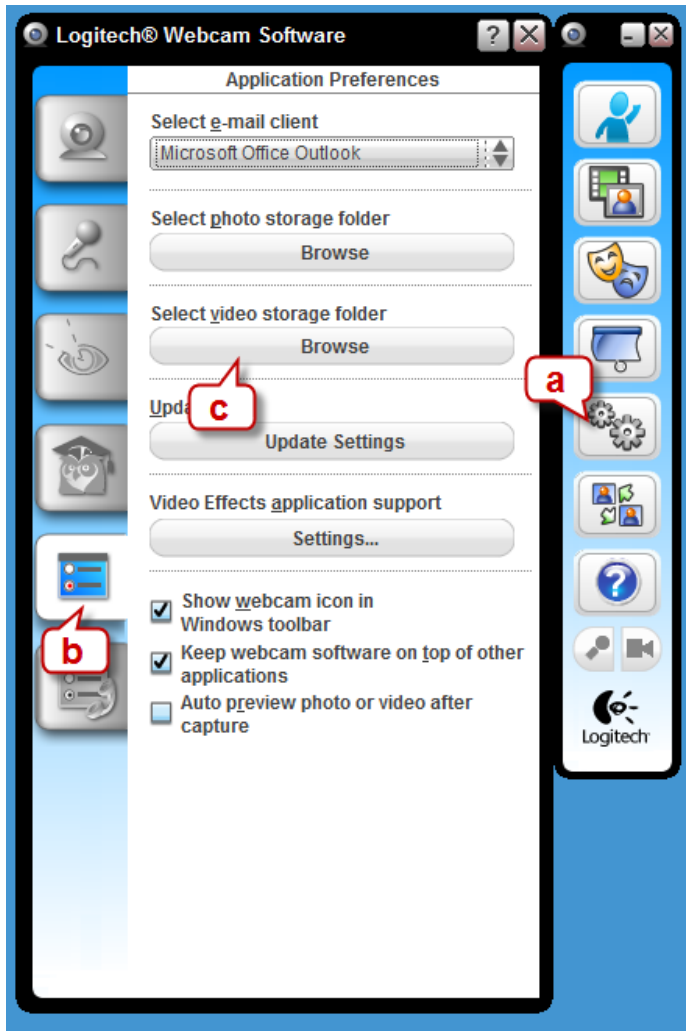
## Folder Setup:

\*\*prior to your first recording, it is suggested that you set up a folder on your personal drive (M)

1. Create a folder on your M drive (ex: MyVideos)

2. Change the settings in Logitech WebCam Software
  - a. Click on the “gears”
  - b. Click on “Application Preferences”
  - c. Click on browse below the “Select video storage folder”  
\*there will be a time delay, please be patient.
  - d. Browse to the folder you created in step 1.

3. Now you are ready to create your videos!



## Create a Video:

\*\*plug in webcam and position it where it best works for your situation.

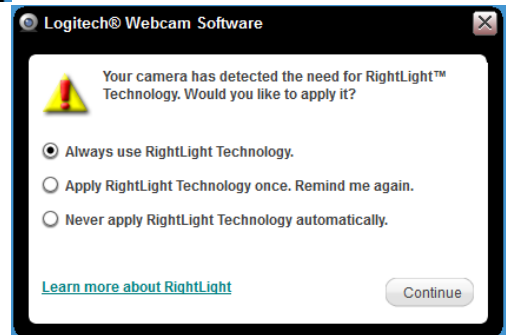
1. Start Logitech Webcam Software
