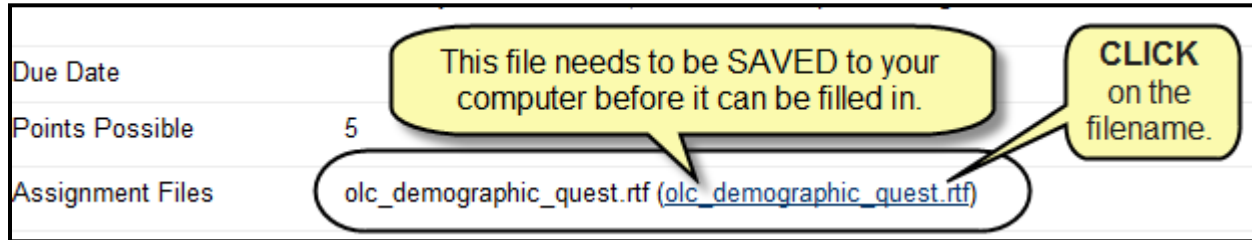


How to Download (SAVE) Files

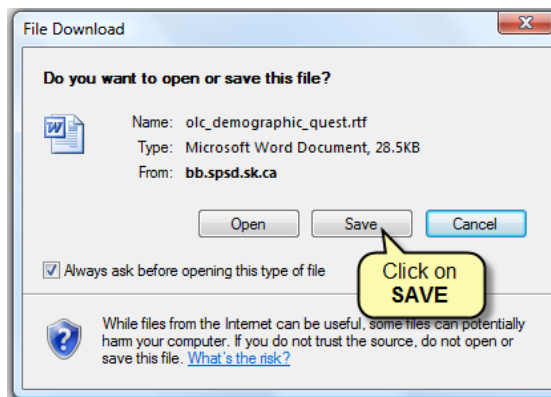
For this example, I will be saving a file from an assignment from the Math B30 online course.



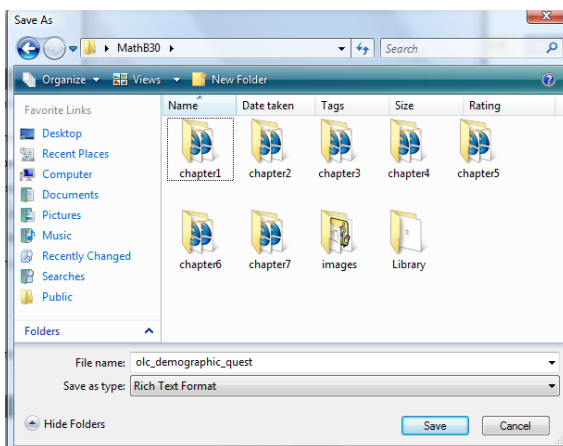
A window will pop open. Instructions for two popular browsers (Internet Explorer and Firefox) are shown below. These instructions are very similar to each other.

INTERNET EXPLORER

- Click on SAVE



- Choose where on your computer you want to save the file.



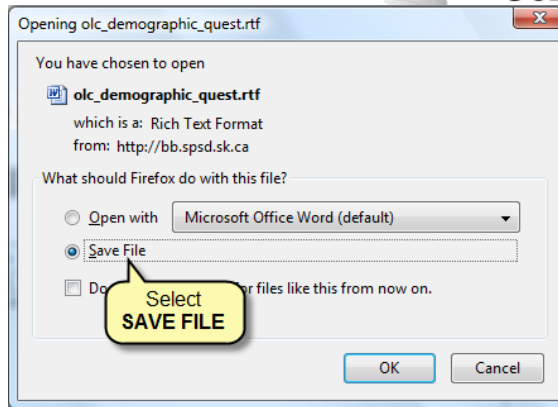
- Click on SAVE

- Once you have saved the file, it is ready for you to use.

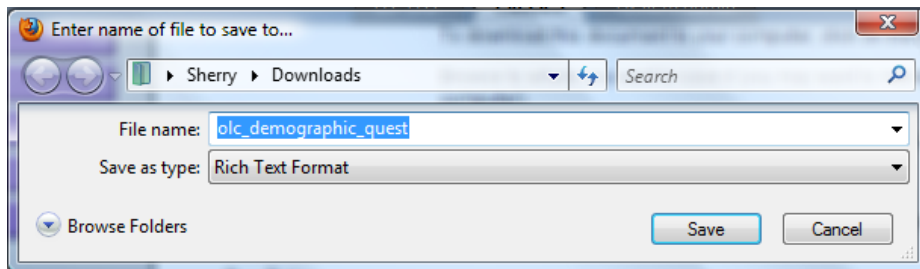
FIREFOX

- Select SAVE FILE

- Click OK



- Choose where on your computer you want to save the file.



- NOTE: If Firefox doesn't ask you where to save, you may want to make Firefox ask this (See Tools → Options → Main)

- Click on SAVE

WARNING:

If you open the file from inside the webpage, there is a chance that the file will not save properly. This could result in lost information.
